WE WELCOME MARK LUTZ!

Mark Lutz joined Opportunity International in 1986 as a key member of the private fundraising team, where he's grown private annual revenue from \$1 million to more than \$40 million.

Mark grew up in South Africa with his missionary parents. Living for 20 years under apartheid shaped him to become an advocate for justice. Visits to 50 countries sharpened his vision for a world free of extreme poverty. Prior to joining Opportunity, Mark served as Senior Director of Resource Development for MAP International, a Christian organization providing life-changing medicines and health supplies to people in need. In 2010, Mark wrote UnPoverty: Rich Lessons from the Working Poor, in which he tells the stories of entrepreneurs who have received micro loans from Opportunity.

Mark earned a Bachelor of Arts in music and a Masters in Cross-Cultural Communication from Wheaton College. Mark and his wife, Lise, live in Glen Ellyn, Illinois, where they raised their three children.

OPPORTUNITY INTERNATIONAL DONATIONS

WALK-IN DINNER FEBRUARY 4

The next walk-in dinner that Wyckoff Reformed Church will prepare and serve is on Saturday, February 4. As usual, we need a crew of 12+ people. If you have helped out in the past or haven't had the chance yet, you are invited to participate in next month's dinner.

If you want to sign up to help serve the food in Hackensack (item 2 below) we need to have those volunteers sign-up quickly, so we can let Family Promise know we will have servers. We need to know if you want to serve by Sunday, January 22.

Several people have already signed up to help. Here is the help we still need:

- 1. Two people to prepare the salad Friday afternoon, February 3 at 2pm.
- 2. Three people to pick-up the cooked food and supplies in the church kitchen, deliver it to the homeless shelter in Hackensack and stay and help place food in containers to be given out. This commitment is on Saturday February 4 from 2 6pm. Volunteers need to be 18 or older, sign a waiver form and need to show proof of vaccination. Volunteer names are needed by Sunday, January 22 and the waiver forms for those people are needed by Tuesday, January 24. If you sign up to serve, we will get the waiver form to you. (If you've served before, we may have your waiver on file.)
