You will be offered bread to tear off a piece and a cup in which to dip the bread and then eat. The elders with prepackaged elements will make their way around the sanctuary to serve those in need of assistance after the others have been served.

Our classrooms are: Nursery (Birth-3), Kids (PreK-3rd grade), and Students (4th-7th grade). Nurseryaged children may be dropped off in the blue room of the Education Building before worship starts. Kids will start the service with their family and be dismissed to their lessons after the Family Moment.

Students will stay in the service since it is a communion Sunday.
