#### WALK-IN DINNER PROGRAM

Family Promise has been hosting the Walk-in Dinner program for 33 years, and Wyckoff Reformed Church has been involved with this program for most of those years. Before Covid, approximately 35,000 meals were served annually. In 2023 approximately 70,000 meals were served. This program continues to need our support with more than 200 people fed daily.

For our next mission, we will help support this program in two ways:

- 1. The next walk-in dinner that WRC is scheduled to prepare and serve is on Saturday, May 4th. We need at least 12 people to help prepare this dinner.
