#### LENTEN DEVOTIONALS

Lent has traditionally been a season when we turn back and focus our lives again on Jesus. The common act of giving something up for Lent is meant to create more space in our lives for Jesus. Whether or not you give something up, we want to invite you to take something new on this Lent to bring you closer to Jesus. This year, instead of a set devotional, we want to encourage you to be creative and find what you need at this step of your journey. Take 10 minutes and pray over how you want to experience Jesus' presence, and consider these as a few options to maybe get you started:

- Daily Devotional Email Many organizations send out daily email devotionals. Sign up for one! Consider devotionals from Gospel in Life, Biola's Center for Christianity, Culture, and the Arts, or Words of Hope.

- Lending Library Worship Committee members have contributed to a Lending Library in the Sanctuary Narthex. Various books fitting for Lent will be available to borrow. Please sign out any books you borrow and make sure to return them at the conclusion of Lent.
- Something else! As you pray, pay attention to where God leads you and be willing to explore something new this season!
